

JACK C. WARTER JR. ARIZONA ELKS YOUTH CAMP RULES

- Check-out time is 1:00 pm.
- Check-in time is 10:00 am.
- All guests under the age of 18 must be accompanied and supervised by an adult; 1 adult for each 6 children.
- No unsupervised underage children are allowed on the property.
- Each group must have at least one person trained in CPR and basic first aid.
- No visitors are allowed in the camp without registering with the Camp Host. No exceptions.
- No pets are allowed in the camp.
- Destroying, removing, or damaging plants, trees, or ground materials is strictly prohibited.
- Any damage to property, buildings, or improved areas is prohibited. Costs associated with any damage will be charged to the group hosting the attendees including withholding any and all deposits.
- Fires are restricted to only the large fire pit area and must be attended at all times. When fire danger is high the USFS places restrictions on fires; and in that case no fires of any kind are allowed. A hose and shovel must be immediately available at all times at the “fire pit” when a fire is active. All fires must be completely extinguished with water prior to leaving the “fire pit.”
- BBQ grills are provided by the camp along with wood/charcoal burning “barrel cookers.” The grills are OK to use during fire restrictions unless directed by the Camp Host. The “barrel cookers” fall under the fire restrictions control.
- Smoking is not allowed in any building or structure. During fire hazard restrictions check with the Camp Host for smoking options.
- Report all accidents and illness to the Camp Host. A written report must be completed by the Camp Host and the supervising adult.
- The use of drugs is strictly forbidden. All guests will be asked to immediately leave if drugs are found and/or used in the camp.
- No fireworks of any kind are allowed in the camp.
- All food and drinks are restricted to the kitchen, dining hall and outside eating area. No food in cabins or the general camp grounds is allowed.
- Camp deposits will be forfeited because of no show or cancellation within 14 days of arrival.
- Per United States Forest Service Title 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b) AND 36 CFR 261.58(m), discharging a firearm, air rifle, or gas gun is prohibited in the Tonto National Forest; therefore, no firearms, air rifles, or gas guns (to include bb guns) are permitted at the camp.
- Contact the Camp Host for any special issues or questions.

Once outside of the camp you are in the Tonto National Forest and under the rules and regulations of the USFS and federal law. If you are unfamiliar with National Forest regulations contact the Tonto National Forest regional office for details.

AEMP CAMP DINING AND KITCHEN RULES

KITCHEN

- **STOVE**: grill, burners, grates, oven, grease trap must be clean and free of grease including new foil grease catchers.
- **SINKS & DRAINBOARDS**: Clean and disinfected.
- **WORK TABLES (KITCHEN & DINING RM)**: Clean and disinfected.
- **POTS, PANS & UTENSILES**: Washed, disinfected, and put away.
- **REFRIGERATORS & FREEZERS**: Empty, cleaned, and disinfected.
- **FLOOR**: Swept and mopped with disinfecting solution.
- **FOOD**: All food must be removed and taken with the camp guest(s).
- **TRASH & GARBAGE CANS**: Trash and waste must be removed and disposed of by the camp visitors. Place new bags placed in all trash and garbage containers.

DINING HALL & OUTSIDE EATING AREA

- **TABLES & CHAIRS**: Cleaned and returned to their original locations.
- **FLOOR**: Swept and mopped using the disinfecting solution.
- **TRASH**: Removed and new liners installed in all trash containers.

DISINFECTING SOLUTION: ½ cup of bleach to 1 gallon of water.
